AREDN report by Ken Hansen. We are ready for the ADEDN final installation.

We are looking for materials for the club website.

We are waiting for responses to our club grants.

Club shack clean-up was performed after last club meeting. We have many items which need to be taken out of the shack and given to members.

Lance Parkes gave us an update on our cloud storage. He will send information to board members about access.

Repeater committee: Dick will update us during the general meeting tonight.

Doyle Taylor was recognized for getting the room opened earlier.

We discussed our experiment tonight with the business meeting being held right before the general meeting.

Ken discussed the idea of a simple portable 31 foot portable tower. <\$2,500

IARC General Meeting 24 May 2018

Meeting called to order by president Ken Hansen N2VIP at 7:42 PM at Senter East park building a few minutes after the business meeting ended. Officers present were: President Ken Hansen N2VIP Vice President James Shugart N5BKL Secretary/Treasurer Tom Shuessler was not present (out of town) Board member Bill Byrom N5BB acted as Secretary/Treasurer for the meeting. July 2018 Page Wesley Dyer fell and broke his hip. He is in the hospital. After prayer and pledge, everyone introduced themselves. 15 people were present (no visitors). Birthdays in May were announced.

EchoLink is still down due to computer internet access issues. Shack renovation: Ken will look at used furniture stores for appropriate tables and other improvements to the room.

ARDEN/ARPS: Cable rerouting is complete. Ken will schedule the additional antenna work. Lance Parkes discussed cloud storage on Google Drive.

Ken discussed the micro grant project. We have notified the four clubs and are waiting for proposals from them. The four clubs who received our request for proposals are: K5UTD ARC Richardson Wireless Klub Dallas ARC Metrocrest ARC

Dennis Brady W5FRS and Bill Byrom N5BB discussed Field Day and we passed around a signup list. The plan is for a one-day Saturday Field Day at Heritage Park. There was some discussion of bands and antennas to be used.

Dick Melcher WA6MDI discussed via telephone during the meeting the repeater engineering work being performed. We will be able to connect 2 or 3 repeaters together. The Kenwood 2M repeater was repaired. The new Bridgecom 220 repeater was discussed. The 440 repeater will be reprogrammed to make it compatible with the controller. The old 2M repeater will need to be reprogrammed. The new duplexer was also discussed, as well as what to do with the old unused controllers. 2M repeater redundancy and use of the Yaesu Fusion DR-1X dual band repeater were also discussed.

Tim Fooks N5MBQ reported on the Independence Day Parade: 8:30am - 11:00am on Wednesday, July 4. The club will have a table set up at Heritage Park.

Dennis Riise describe future access badges to the hospital for repeater work. He also reported that Gary Dallas W5BFA (previous member of the IARC) passed away recently.

\$30 cash dues were accepted from: Larry Saletzki WA9VRH Rick Rhein (no call yet) We believe they both submitted membership applications and these were approved at a previous meeting.

The club netted \$10 cash from the 50/50 raffle. Three prizes were distributed based on attendance tickets.

We will probably hold the business meeting on the second Thursday of June and make a decision at that time about holding future meetings on the same night
