Combined meeting February 28, 2019

The meeting opened at 7:21 PM at Betcha Bingo.

- Concerns: Dennis Riise K5AVT had a small clot and has been released from the hospital to his house. Dave Dobbin's brother recently passed away.
- After prayer and pledge we had introductions and listed birthdays.
- Minutes were not available from the January meeting.
- We did not have a Treasurer's report.
- Old business:
 - All three AREDN sector antennas are now up high. The back haul antenna is now installed halfway up the tower. The tower lights were repaired.
 - We need to schedule a follow-up work party to complete the AREDN project (mainly to point the backhaul antenna to the UTD tower).
- New business:
 - The Nominations Committee was appointed by the President as follows:
 - Bill Byrom N5BB
 - James Shugart N5BKL
 - The IARC approved a \$500 payment to David Darcy KF5LKG for tower work to move the AREDN antennas.
 - The IARC approved a \$5,000 donation to Great Days of Service. The check was presented to Andy Schellenberg from that organization. Andy thanked us for funding this organization more than any other donation source. He spoke about how their group works. Eight religious groups assist them, including the Irving Islamic Center and Cistercian Abbey School. The Great Days of Service work days this year will be the last Friday/Saturday of March and the first Friday/Saturday of April.
 - The IARC approved \$150 for an AREDN Betcha Bingo Hamshack node.
 - We need to put announcements on the club repeater.
 - The IARC approved \$1,000 to seed the Irving Hamfest cashbox.
 - The following new members were approved by vote:
 - Joe Medrano KA5ZBP
 - David Darcy KF5LKG (complimentary)
 - Charles Martin N5MUO
 - Jon Hager KD5NCX (rejoining after many years of inactivity)
- General Meeting old business:
 - Betcha Bingo Shack Renovation
 - Network hardline from Betcha Bingo office to club shack was found
 - Echolink needs to be moved to a new computer
 - One shack UPS has a failed battery pack – will defer replacing battery until needed
 - Antennas

- Fan dipole end anchors appear to be disconnecte
- Discussed adding a second VHF/UHF antenna (possibly 2m/1.25m/70 cm)
- AREDN node needs to be purchased configured, and installed (simple point-to-point connecting shack and repeater site)
- Repeater committee
 - UPS for repeater site has been purchased and needs to be moved to the site
 - Repeater operational problems have been resolved with a donated repair. The 2 meter repeater is now repaired and bak on line
- Website committee
 - The Club calendar needs to be updated once we decide on future meeting locations (library or regular park locations)
 - We need articles and activity on our website/Facebook/etc. to show that the IARC is active to encourage new members
- Winter Field Day report – this was a successful event involving three clubs
- Boy Scouts – no update on any upcoming events
- Program:
 - Irving Hamfest discussion
 - So far we have 66 tables sold or committed
 - Volunteer schedule
 - 6:30 AM – ticket sales
 - 6:30 AM – security
 - Frame antenna discussion
- The meeting adjourned at 8:56 PM.
