## Christmas Meeting 12/19/19



- 7. Old Business
  - a. iPower Reimbursement Ken Hansen
    - i. Owed to Ken Hansen: \$651.00 (2015-2019)
    - ii. Includes 1 final year of domain registration and webhosting through 11/19. Official motion to reimburse Ken for these expenses was made, seconded and approved .
    - iii. Need to secure club debit card to takeover annual domain registration (and other recurring) charges. Tom Schuessler will contact Bank of America and begin process.
    - iv. Domain Registration now \$17.99/yr for irvingarc.org domain
  - b. Home Depot table-top shelving
    - i. owed to Ken Hansen \$72.44 for these purchases;
    - ii. 4 pcs bought, in club shack at Betcha Bingo
    - iii. Will create 2x two shelf "racks", one for each desk in shack
  - c. Texas VHF-FM Society membership. Ken Hansen reported on his experiences attending on of the VHF-FM society meetings.
    - i. Ken Hansen will assume repeater trustee role
    - ii. Owed to Ken Hansen \$15.00. the club reimbursed.
  - d. Last month Ken was concerned that there might have been a missing, recently purchased repeater. In reality, he found that all Club repeaters located, were in "Vault" the whole time
  - e. "Backup" UHF Duplexer, tuned for active IARC UHF pair purchased from Dennis Riise, have been paid for, and placed in "Vault"
  - f. AREDN Node equipment purchased for \$200, placed in "Vault"
  - g. Half of approved \$300 for roof-top mounting hardware and supplies (non-penetrating mount, cable, coax, mast, etc.) for AREDN node hardware AND additional dual/triple-band V/UHF antenna (CX-333, 2m, 1.25m, 70cm) will be applied to CX-333 antenna, tri-plexer purchase 9/27/19

### 8. New Business

- a. Tax Accountant/CPA fees for 2018 tax year of \$700 was approved by membership. Ken concurs that using a professional firm also satisfies our need for an annual "Audit of our financial dealings.
- b. Reimburse Accountant/CPA for refunded penalty from Tax Year 2017. Penalty was reversed by IRS on insistence from CPA and club will deposit refund.

    - Assorted tools and accessories for Betcha Bingo Shack – Anderson PowerPole kit, coax crimp connector install kit, two PowerPole power distribution units (one for each workstation), braided wire to ground radios, etc. that were approved last meeting were not purchased (order to be placed Friday, 9/27)
    - Betcha Bingo Shack Inventory work party update; Tom Schuessler reports that good progress has been made identifying what items found on old inventories no longer exist in the club's possession.
  - b. Repeater Committee
    - i. Need to promote meeting programs on club repeater
      - Update on Voice Prompt Programming? Bill Byrom has taken on challenge of programming repeater announcements. Was not at the meeting. Several others have agreed to assist.
      - 2. Ken Hansen reports that he does hope to activate second UHF repeater pair at Bingo Hall once tri-band antenna installed.
  - c. Boy Scouts
    - i. Upcoming Events; Tom Schuessler will be heading a Radio Merit Badge class at Camp Wisdom on December 7<sup>th</sup>. Will be seeking additional volunteer help.
  - d. Irving Volunteer Day report; Billy Geer discussed that

we had a good turn out of club and RACES members supporting our table space, but the attendance of the general ublic was low. It seemed there were more people form the various agencies than general public.

- e. Sept. 12<sup>th</sup> MOTA report; The consensus of the club was that it was successful. All want to se it continue.
