Field Day

This year we will be participating in Field Day in what I would consider a 'casual' mode - we'll set up in a local park, we'll eat a couple meals, and we'll operate some radios. There are plans to set up a CW station, a Digital (FT8) station, and an SSB (voice) station, and we'd welcome everyone to stop by. VE Testing

Roger Bacak reached out to me last month and requested two Amazon 8" Fire Tablets to explore running out VE testing 'electronically'. In the past we offered tests thru both the ARRL and the W5YI VE programs, but W5YI is going 'all electronic' and Roger, our VE Coordinator is considering only testing for W5YI going forward. To that end, Roger is requesting 6 more tablets & cases (at <\$125 each tablet & case).

In addition Roger is asking for additional club members to sign up as VEs with W5YI and to assist with VE testing. The process is simple, and the more VE testers we have, the easier the commitment. We already partner with Dallas Amateur Radio Club, with both clubs helping each other staff their testing sessions.
