Help Wanted

Repeater Committee:

Looking for a club member to assist in overseeing the IARC Repeater infrastructure, both the repeaters on "the hospital" and at "the EOC site".

The ideal candidate would have an interest in managing the repeaters the club relies on to provide coverage across the area. Responsibilities will include investigating and resolving issues with any of the club repeaters (employing outside resources to resolve outstanding issues beyond their abilities), implementing technology and procedures to remotely manage club repeaters, and evaluate, design and implement new technologies in the repeater infrastructure. Potential projects include AllStar, Broadcastify streaming, Digital Modulation (C4FM/Fusion, etc.), and other enhancements as the club membership may desire.

The candidate selected for this position will be required to obtain required City of Irving and Baylor Scott & White Hospital Identification credentials to ensure access to either repeater sites

Hamfest Committee:

Looking for a club member to assist in overseeing the 2024 IARC Hamfest this coming March. The ideal candidate will have an interest in planning, coordinating, and overseeing the Hamfest, and possibly taking a more significant role in future Hamfests. The work is not hard, it will not occupy more than a few hours of your time per month. Responsibilities will include alerting Ham Publications and websites of the planned event, determining door prizes, printing the admission and door prize tickets, overseeing ticket and table sales, Bingo Hall set up and take down, as well as oversight during the event and reporting to the club the results of the Hamfest (attendees, ticket/table sales, revenue generated, and so on)..

Club Station Committee:

Looking for a club member to assist in overseeing the club radio station ("shack") at the Betcha Bingo II bingo hall. The ideal candidate will take charge of the space, keep it clean/organized, and be responsible for opening the shack to fellow club members interested in operating the club station during pre-arranged, or scheduled, times throughout the year. Projects the Club Station Committee will consider and, if approved, will execute on will include, but not be limited to upgrading the EchoLink computer system and relocating the equipment to the shack, upgrading the VHF/UHF operating position to support "weak signal" SSB operation, configuring the HF operating position for remote operation by club members, and possibly even establishing a basic satellite station with a small "Sat Pack" antenna array on an Az-El rotor. The ideal candidate must be willing to make themselves available – at a minimum – to open the shack for a few hours several times a week (including weekend mornings), or arrange a fellow club member to take on this responsibility.

We also found a small number of adapters and cables we need to get the Signalink and the GPS in the Anytone working.
